FJMCAANA Post-Graduate Loan Program

Fatima Jinnah Medical College Alumni Association of North America has started a loan program to address needs of graduates for financial assistance for residency applications in their transition to the United States.

Determining Committee

All loan applications are to be screened by the General Secretary of the FJMCAANA Executive Council. Determination of loan eligibility is to be done by members of the FJMCAANA Executive Council in North America in collaboration with FJMU Faculty in Pakistan.

Loan Amount

Maximum amount is \$5000 per candidate. This is a non-interest loan that will be awarded in full and then needs to be paid back in full within 5 years of starting residency. The loan amount must be repaid regardless of residency status. If residency is not obtained within 2 years, the repayment plan will then be decided by FJMCAANA Executive Council in collaboration with the applicant. The applicant who receives this loan MUST send ALL RECEIPTS of what was purchased with this loan, i.e., registration fee for USMLE, ERAS application, fees for residency etc.

Criteria for Applicants

1. Must be a graduate of Fatima Jinnah Medical University.
2. Candidate must be in the US or have positive visa status (green card or H1 visa).
3. Step 1 Pass. Step 2 score of 240 or higher.
4. 3 months of US Externship experience.

Instructions for application

1. Must complete FJMCAANA Post-Graduate Loan application.
2. Ensure all supporting documents are complete (see below).
3. Email complete application and supporting documents, except Notary form to team@fjmcaana.org
4. Notary form must be mailed to the General Secretary of FJMCAANA.

Supporting Documents

1. Copy of Curriculum Vitae
2. Copy of Pakistani Passport
3. Copy of NICOP
4. Copy of USA Visa or Green Card
5. Notarized Affidavit at the initiation of loan (must be mailed to General Secretary FJMCAANA)
6. Copy of Medical Diploma
7. Copy of USMLE Step 1, Step 2 certificate & Step 3 certificate (Step 3 whenever applicable)
8. 2 Letters of Recommendations (one must be from United States)
