Mentoring FJMU Graduates in the U.S./Canada Residency Pathway

FJMCAANA created a dedicated USMLE Mentoring WhatsApp group to reach FJMU students earlier in the process and increase awareness of U.S. and Canadian residency pathways. The group now includes more than 120 FJMU students who are currently preparing for or taking USMLE Step 1 or Step 2, creating an expanding platform for mentorship, guidance, peer support, and early exposure to the residency pathway.

This initiative complements FJMCAANA's participation in IMG Zoom meetings, mentorship for observership opportunities, and panel discussions focused on postgraduate training and professional development.
